VINEYARD NOTES

Growing Season

The 2013 season began with a warm, dry spring, bringing an early bud break, with consistently ideal temperatures through summer, offering optimal vine activity and beautiful ripening. The Chardonnay grapes arrived at a furious pace in August, providing an ample harvest which enabled wine growers to hand-pick favorable grapes, perfectly reflected in the 2013 Eagle Glen Chardonnay.

Location

The 2013 Chardonnay grapes were carefully selected and harvested from a renowned Los Carneros vineyard and picked at an average of 25.8° Brix and hand-sorted before a cold soak and barrel fermentation.

TASTING NOTES

A unique Napa Valley Chardonnay, the 2013 Eagle Glen Chardonnay boasts floral aromas of violet and honeysuckle with distinct, tropical fruits slowly rising from the glass. Pouring a light, buttery golden color, the flavors on the palate echo a nut-like complexity, accented with a naturally rich mouthfeel. Focused acids move across the palate and linger, offsetting a decadent, mineral finish.
